



## HORTICULTURE INTERNSHIPS

Gain horticulture experience at The Battery Conservancy. Participate in all aspects of organic sustainable horticulture in this 25-acre historic public park at the southern tip of Manhattan on New York Harbor. Work with The Battery Conservancy horticulture team in caring for extensive naturalistic herbaceous perennial gardens designed by plantsman Piet Oudolf, perennial nursery, trees and turf, Labyrinth native plant meadow, and the new gardens of Peter Minuit Plaza. Routine maintenance includes weeding, watering, planting, grooming perennials, mulching, and pruning.

### Qualifications:

- Minimum of one year of professional landscaping field experience and/or horticultural school.
- Ability to take direction and work well with other people.
- The intern will also work with other seasonal staff and volunteers while performing daily duties.
- Perform heavy physical labor on a daily basis. Must be able to lift and carry 40 lbs.
